

# Caps for Good Crocheted Cap Pattern



EASY

## Abbreviation Key

“ = inch(es)  
ch = chain  
dc = double crochet  
lp = loop(s)  
mm = millimeter(s)  
oz = ounce(s)  
sc = single crochet  
rnd = round  
rep = repeat  
sl st = slip stitch  
st(s) = stitch(es)  
Size: 12” circumference



## Materials



Medium-weight yarn, 1 oz  
Crochet hook size H (5mm) or size required for gauge  
Yarn needle to weave in ends

## Gauge

7 dc = 2”

## INSTRUCTIONS

Rnd 1:

Ch 4, work 11 dc in 4th ch from hook; join with a sl st to top of beg ch: counts as 12 dc.

Rnd 2:

Ch 3 (counts as first dc, now and throughout), dc in joining ch; 2 dc in each dc around, join: 24 dc.

Rnd 3:

Ch 3, dc in joining ch; \*dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc; rep from \* around, join: 32 dc.

Rnds 4 through 11:

Ch 3, dc in the top two loops of each dc around; join.

Rnd 12:

Sc crochet in the top two loops of dc around; join, finish off. Weave in all ends. Turn cuff up.
